Inauguration:

Dr. M. T. "We have to protect intellectual property and it cannot be done in a manner we generally adopt for physical property." Session by Dr. Mangesh J. Pawar on "Intellectual Property Rights (IPR)"

Dr. Mangesh Pawar sir highlighted the importance of documenting ideas properly and patenting it, he said that in the coming years the country will be known for its scientific creations in different fields ranging from agriculture to space research. "Protection for their intellectual property will be an encouragement to budding scientists to come out with more innovations and inventions," he added. Dr. Mangesh Pawar sir gave basic idea about invention and patent. He also thoroughly explained various benefits of IPRs. He gave real example to understand important of patent and copyright. He provides many pictorial examples therefore student and faculty very clearly understood various aspects of IPRs. Dr. Pawar sir has explained about rules and regulation about IPRs in India and also explains how to file a copy right and patent. The session was very interactive. Student and faculty had asked many questions to resource person to gain knowledge about untouched field of IPRs.


